**PORT ISABEL-SAN BENITO NAVIGATION DISTRICT  
NAVIGATION & CANAL COMMISSION ORDINANCE 2015-4  
REGARDING SPEED LIMIT ON ROADWAYS ON PISBND PROPERTY**  
(Pursuant to Section 60.071, et seq., of the Texas Water Code)

Be it Ordained by the Navigation and Canal Commission of the PORT ISABEL-SAN BENITO NAVIGATION DISTRICT (hereafter "PISBND") that, due to various persons driving at high rates of speed on PISBND property, as the PISBND finds it is necessary to control the operation of all types of vehicles (particularly their speed) using the roads maintained by the District, other than roads dedicated to public use by formal dedication, and to prescribe the speed, lighting and other requirements of these vehicles using the property of PISBND, under the authority of PISBND to supervise the areas comprising the real property of PISBND, and the waterways within, establishes a "SPEED LIMIT" Ordinance, as follows, under Section Sec. 60.072 (1) of the Texas Water Code.

Upon the enactment of this Ordinance, by the said Commission, in accordance with the said provisions of the Texas Water Code, the phrase "SPEED LIMIT of 15-Miles Per Hour" will be set forth on signs that will be posted in and about PISBND, to prevent "speeding" by any and all vehicles on PISBND property. This Ordinance is enforceable by any duly constituted peace officer of Cameron County and of The State Of Texas, in accordance with Section 60.077 of the Texas Water Code and Article 2.12 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

This Ordinance, under Section 60.075 of the Texas Water Code, will be effective, after being published in a newspaper published in the District, after the ten-day period following the adoption of this Order; a violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor, and the Commission has provided for the punishment of that misdemeanor by that fine of not more than \$500 for each offense or violation.
