**PORT ISABEL-SAN BENITO NAVIGATION DISTRICT
NAVIGATION & CANAL COMMISSION ORDINANCE 2015-2
REGARDING NO FISHING ON PISBND PROPERTY
(Pursuant to Section 60.071, et seq., of the Texas Water Code)**

Be it Ordained by the Navigation and Canal Commission of the PORT ISABEL-SAN BENITO NAVIGATION DISTRICT (hereafter "PISBND") that, due to various "unauthorized" persons trespassing and fishing on PISBND property, as the PISBND finds it is necessary to protect the property, and to prohibit loitering on or in docks, wharves, piers, warehouses, sheds or other properties of the PISBND, under the authority of PISBND to supervise the areas comprising the real property of PISBND and the waterways within, establishes a "NO FISHING" Ordinance, as follows, under Section 60.072 (2) of the Texas Water Code.

Upon the enactment of this Ordinance, by the said Commission, in accordance with the said provisions of the Texas Water Code, the phrase "NO FISHING" will be set forth on signs that will be posted in and about PISBND, to prevent "NO FISHING" on PISBND property. This Ordinance is enforceable by any duly constituted peace officer of Cameron County and of The State Of Texas, in accordance with Section 60.077 of the Texas Water Code and Article 2.12 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

This Ordinance, under Section 60.075 of the Texas Water Code, will be effective, after being published in a newspaper published in the District, after the ten-day period following the adoption of this Order; a violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor, and the Commission has provided for the punishment of that misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$500 for each offense or violation.
